The University of Oregon's Chinese Flagship Program is the only undergraduate program in the country designed specifically for advanced Mandarin Chinese language learners. This honors-level cross-disciplinary program allows students to build on their Mandarin skills and interests while pursuing any of the 137 different academic majors offered at the University of Oregon.

Who Should Apply?

The Flagship Program is geared toward advanced-level Chinese language learners. Applicants are evaluated based on their demonstrated Mandarin proficiency, commitment to personal and educational growth, teacher recommendations, and ways in which students will add to the depth and diversity of the Flagship program.

- Take upper-level content and language strategies courses taught exclusively in Chinese
- Live in the UO International House and participate in Flagship's innovative language-learning environment
- Explore academic interests and choose a major from among 137 different programs at the University of Oregon
- Apply Mandarin language skills and gain hands-on experience through various internship opportunities
- Spend junior year at Nanjing University, taking courses in major fields of study and specific interests
- Explore future opportunities through individualized career counseling and introductions to potential employers
- Apply for generous scholarships awarded to top applicants (U.S. citizenship or U.S. permanent residency required)

Scholarship Opportunity!

The UO Chinese Flagship application process is competitive. Applicants will be reviewed based on Chinese proficiency, community involvement, academic record, teacher recommendations, and the ways in which the student will add to the depth and diversity of the Flagship Program. Advanced Chinese language learners of all backgrounds are welcome to apply.

All students accepted into the Chinese Flagship Program will benefit from a broad range of challenging and innovative courses and learning opportunities. Top applicants will be awarded generous scholarships.

To qualify for a Flagship scholarship, applicants are required to be accepted into the University of Oregon and submit financial aid applications to FAFSA, the UO Diversity Building scholarship (DBS), and other University of Oregon institutional scholarships.
