2011 CLTA Professional Development Grant Award for Announcement

The Chinese Language Teachers Association has awarded Professional Development Grants in support of workshops and conferences organized by the following regional associations: Colorado Chinese Language Teachers Consortium (CCLTC), Chinese Language Teachers Association of California (CLTAC), Chinese Language Teachers Association of Texas (CLTA-Texas), and Wisconsin Association of Chinese Language Teachers (WACLTC).

The CLTA Professional Development Grant Awards up to \$1,000 for each proposal to support professional development for K-16 teachers to improve classroom instruction and student participation. Regional Chinese language teachers organizations that have formally affiliated with CLTA are eligible to apply. Grant recipients are required to acknowledge CLTA in any literature they distribute about their programs and submit a one-page report within a month after completing the proposed events. The next dead-
